KKV Foundation Scholarship examination eligibility criteria:

1. In 2020 only Cameroun and Indian citizens can apply for scholarship exam.

Eligibility for students from India (For Bachelor's Degree):

1. Class 12 or equivalent exam conducted by a recognized Central or State board like ICSE, CBSE, CISE etc.
2. 12'th class appearing student must submit 12'th Marksheet and passing certificate before they receive a scholarship Visa.
3. Candidates who have passed class 12 or any other equivalent exam in 2018 or 2019 or those who will be appearing in class 12'th or any other equivalent examination in 2020 will be eligible to appearing KKV Foundation scholarship examination 2020.
4. Candidates must be present in full time for their study program.
5. Candidates must have an overall aggregate of 50% Marks or equivalence CGPA.

Eligibility for students from India (For Master's Degree):

1. Candidates must have passed graduation in engineering and technology or Master's degree in any relevant science subjects.
2. Candidate holds a bachelor's degree with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA.

Eligibility for students from Cameroon:

1. High school graduates must submit a high school diploma before they receive a scholarship Visa.
2. Candidates who have passed Baccalaureate or any other equivalent exam in 2018 or 2019 or those who will be appearing in Baccalaureate or any other equivalent examination in 2020 will be eligible to appearing KKV Foundation scholarship examination 2020.
3. Students in Terminal class are eligible to participate in the 2020 scholarship examination.
4. Candidates must be present in full time for their study program.
